Children who attend camp can use the camp experience to share their emotions and stories in a safe, nurturing, fun environment. Also, while participating in the variety of summer camp activities, children gain social confidence and the ability to better cope with the challenges that can be caused by their burns. The Summer Camp for Burn Injured Youth is a continuation of our care program for children with life-altering burn injuries – seeking to promote healing and life beyond injury. We support burn survivors of all ages in all stages of recovery.

Overnight Camp serves kids ages 7 to 17 and is a week long program.

Explorers Camp is a one day program for kids under the age of 7 or any child not ready for overnight camp.

The Young Adult Leadership Program (YALP) is for survivors ages 18–21 and focuses on building leadership skills. Many YALP graduates transition into camp staff roles at age 21.
